IMMUNIZATION SCHEDULE

Recommended immunizations & tests at each check up

Physical exams are recommended at 2 weeks, 2, 4, 6,9,12, 15,18, 24 & 30 months and annually from 3 years on. Physical exams are necessary to provide medical information required by some camp and school forms. No more than 3 injections with one oral will be given at any one visit.

State law requires the following minimum doses: 5 Dtap, 4 IPV, 4 HIB, 3 Hep B, 2 MMR, 1 Varicella

Who should get Tdap?

- Ages 7-10 who has not had any Pertussis vaccine or has not finished the series
- Ages 65 and older, especially if in contact with newborn/infants

Tdap can be given regardless of the time since previous tetanus booster.

When to give Menactra (MCV4) boosters

- If received initial dose at age 11-12, booster at 16 or up to 5 years after initial dose
- If received initial dose at age 13-15, booster at age 16-18
